WHAT ARE THE 5 RIVERS?



You may be wondering at this point, what are the 5 Rivers? Well, that's a great question. Trout Unlimited and Costa sunglasses decided that there were 5 very important areas for college fly fishing clubs to focus their efforts. Those areas are conservation, fundraising, community outreach, TU connection and Costa ambassadorship. To remain a part of the 5 Rivers program and have access to the student discount program, your club should complete all the 5 Rivers.

1.) **CONSERVATION**: Each club will host at least one conservation initiative a semester. This can be anything from a creek clean-up, a trout in the classroom project, a STREAM girls' event, water monitoring project and much more.

2.) **FUNDRAISING:** Money is imperative to the success of all 5 rivers clubs. Therefore, we ask that you complete at least one fundraising event each semester. This could be a film showing event with a raffle, profit sharing night at a local restaurant, merchandise sales and much more. The options here are endless so get creative and raise some money for your club!

3.) **COMMUNITY**: Creating a fly fishing community is also a cornerstone of the 5 Rivers program. Make sure

that your events are fun, engaging and supportive. To accomplish this, work to build a diverse club full of anglers of varying skill levels, races, genders and more. In addition, work to build relationships outside of your university. Connect with the local community in ways that raise awareness of your club and promote unity through fly fishing.

4.) **TU CONNECTION**: Each 5 Rivers club needs to be involved with their local Trout Unlimited chapter. These local chapters can be your greatest resources for fishing knowledge, planning events, fundraising and becoming intertwined with your local community. We recommend having a specific club officer responsible for building and maintaining this connection.

5.) COSTA AMBASSADORSHIP: The president of every 5 Rivers club will take on the role of being a Costa Ambassador. As a Costa Ambassador, you are not asked to take on any additional duties besides creating the best club possible. We ask that you do a fantastic job at your current role by growing membership, bringing your mem-

bers to rendezvous events, planning successful events, gatherings, meetings, and conservation projects. By accomplishing this, each president will receive a free pair of Costa sunglasses.

SUPPORT

As a 5 Rivers Club, you will receive support from both national and local chapters of Trout Unlimited. The 5 Rivers coordinator (Cliff) is here to help you with getting your club started, publicity, club orders, event logistics and more. Your local TU chapter is also a great resource. They can help you with local fly fishing knowledge, fundraising, and planning/ executing events.

NETWORK

EVENTS

The TU Costa 5 Rivers program is known for our industry shattering events. Whether it is virtual or in-person, you can count on a fun time and some gear giveaways. Each year, we host 4 regional rendezvous (Midwest, Southeast, Northeast and Western) in which we invite clubs from these areas to join us for a weekend of fishing, conservation, and fun. In addition to the rendezvous, each summer we host the Costa Ambassador Summit. This is a weeklong leadership summit in the Rocky Mountain region with club presidents from around the country. We also offer exclusive virtual classes, speaker events and film showings.
